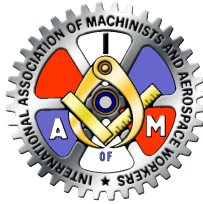

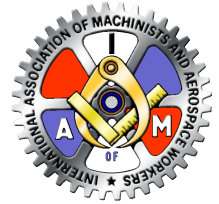

Your IAM Negotiating Committee passed our counter proposal back to the Company on Saturday. We were expecting to receive a “last, best and final” offer from the Company today. Instead, they walked out of the room without proposing anything. There will not be a vote on Wednesday to combine the Cessna and Beechcraft bargaining unit contracts.

Rest assured that your Negotiating Committee fought tooth and nail for you — and put forth a realistic contract proposal that focused on the issues you outlined in your survey: health care, job security and seniority. We are disappointed the Company couldn’t put their best foot forward to at least meet us in the middle.
